

Sharing an iMovie project file

Upload project file to iTunes (iTunes 11 or newer)




5. Open iTunes on the computer


10. Drag your project to the desktop or click **Save to** 11. In iTunes, click the **eject** symbol and then disconnect the iPad from the computer

- 2. Log into your UMN email/Google Drive account




Load iMovie project into a different iPad using iTunes (PC or Mac)
